
Acceptable Configuration

Brand Identity

Trademarks presented must meet the following specification. Brand Name : LUXA2 Pronunciation : [lu - sa - tu] Domain: www.LUXA2.com Brand in Text Form : LUXA2 (Do not use lowercase letters of the alphabet.)

Alignment Grid

All elements forming Thermaltake Logo are arranged in a precise relationship to each other; the alignment grid below shows the correct configuration and proportion of the logo elements. Resizing or duplication of Thermaltake logo must strictly follow these criteria to assure the memorability and consistency of Thermaltake corporate image.



Minimum Logo Size

To protect legibility and impact, Thermaltake logo must be reproduced in sizes no smaller than those shown below.

Color Specification

Color design in brand identity symbols is one important element for high recognition value. The specific colors used in LUXA2 logo are provided below with the color list in the most commonly used media formats. Use the CMYK format instead of the distinctive pantone format in exceptional circumstances.



Background Dos and Don'ts

LUXA2 logo may be placed over any background color or images. However, colors and textures of the background must be selected accordingly to maximize legibility. Insufficient contrast between the logo and the background should be avoided.

Clear Space Requirements

Proper margin/ clear space allowances around the LUXA2 logo must be maintained to ensure strong presence and enhance visual effectiveness. The "X" height as demonstrated in the diagram below is the minimum clear space requirements that should be treated as an integral part of LUXA2 logo; it is also the minimum margin in any working materials with predefined or restricted space. The presence of gray frames, lines and dotted lines in the below illustration is for clear space illustration only, which should not appear in the actual print.

Exceptions

When conflict between the background patterns and clear space is unavoidable, maximum contrast must be ensured to retain the impact of LUXA2 logo.

Improper Logo Usage

All applications of Thermaltake logo should be consistent to strengthen and maintain the strong corporate image; any alternations or distortion on the style or color that hinders the effectiveness of Thermaltake logo should be avoided. Please see examples of improper logo usage below:
